TRACK AND FACILITIES MANAGEMENT PLAN:

MISSION STATEMENT:

TO PROVIDE A SAFE, FUN AND ORGANIZED RIDING FACILITY FOR ALL AGES AND SKILL LEVELS. WHILE CREATING A WORLD CLASS RACING ORGANIZATION FOR HOSTING LOCAL, REGIONAL AND NATIONAL RACE EVENTS.

MANAGEMENT PLAN:

WEEKDAYS:

- HOURS OF OPERATION 12PM TO 9PM
- TYPE OF RIDING ON THE WEEKDAYS WILL BE PRACTICE AND RECREATIONAL RIDING OPEN TO ALL AGES AND SKILL LEVEL.
- 50 TO 100 RIDERS WILL USE THE TRACKS. FEW SPECTATORS AND FAMILIES OF RIDERS WILL BE PRESENT.
- ALL RIDERS WILL SIGN IN AT THE FRONT GATE SIGN A WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM ANY PAY A DAILY FEE FOR RIDING THE TRACK.
- ALL MINORS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A LEGAL GUARDIAN AND MUST HAVE A SIGNED MINOR WAIVER AND RELEASE BY THAT GUARDIAN.
- ALL RIDERS MUST REED THE LIST OF RULES AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE RULES OF THE PARK.

NON-RACE WEEKENDS:

- HOURS OF OPERATION 10AM TO 7PM
- TYPE OF RIDING ON THE NON RACE WEEKENDS WILL BE PRACTICE AND RECREATIONAL RIDING OPEN TO ALL AGES AND SKILL LEVELS
- 50 TO 150 RIDERS WILL USE THE TRACKS. FEW SPECTATORS AND FAMILIES OF RIDERS WILL BE PRESENT.
- ALL RIDERS WILL SIGN IN AT THE FRONT GATE SIGN A WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM ANY PAY A DAILY FEE FOR RIDING THE TRACK.
- ALL MINORS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A LEGAL GUARDIAN AND MUST HAVE A SIGNED MINOR WAIVER AND RELEASE BY THAT GUARDIAN.
- ALL RIDERS MUST REED THE LIST OF RULES AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE RULES OF THE PARK.

RACE WEEKENDS:

- HOURS OF OPERATION FRIDAY 12PM TO 10PM SATURDAY 8AM TO 10PM SUNDAY 8AM TO 7PM
- CAMPING WILL BE AVAILABLE ON ALL RACE WEEKENDS FRIDAY AND SATURDAY NIGHT. CAMPING WILL ALSO BE AVAILABLE DURING THE SUMMER MONTHS FOR KIDS RIDING CAMPS, CHURCH GROUP OUTINGS AND OTHER EVENTS. CAMPING WILL ONLY BE PERMITTED IN THE PARKING AREA AND IT IS FOR THE SOLE USE BY GUESTS AND PATRONS OF THE MOTOCROSS PARK.
- CAMPERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO OBSERVE QUIET HOURS. NO MOTORCYCLES PIT BIKES ATVS WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE RUN AFTER THE TRACK HAS SHUT DOWN FOR THE DAY.
- SECURITY STAFF WILL BE PRESENT ALL HOURS THERE ARE CAMPERS PRESENT.
- TYPE OF RIDING ON RACE WEEKENDS IS FOR RACE COMPETITION. CLASSES ARE AVAILABLE FOR ALL AGES AND SKILL LEVELS.
- RIDERS WILL RACE ON THE TRACK WITH ONLY RIDERS OF THE SAME SKILL LEVEL AND OR AGE CLASS.
- 100 TO 400 RIDERS WILL USE THE TRACKS. 50 TO 500 SPECTATORS AND FAMILIES OF RIDERS WILL BE PRESENT
- ALL RIDERS WILL SIGN IN AT THE FRONT GATE SIGN A WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM ANY PAY A FEE FOR EACH CLASS THE RIDER WILL PARTICIPATE IN.
- ALL MINORS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A LEGAL GUARDIAN AND MUST HAVE A SIGNED MINOR WAIVER AND RELEASE BY THAT GUARDIAN.
- ALL RIDERS MUST READ THE LIST OF RULES AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE RULES OF THE PARK.
- SPECTATORS WILL ALSO BE REQUIRED TO PAY A GATE FEE AND SIGN A WAIVER AND RELEASE.
- SPECTATORS MUST READ THE LIST OF RULES AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE RULES OF THE PARK.

RULES AND GUIDELINES:

- RULES WILL BE ENFORCED BY TRACK STAFF AND SECURITY. ANYONE NOT ABIDING BY THESE RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE. THERE WILL BE STAFF AND SECURITY PRESENT AT ALL TIMES THERE ARE PEOPLE IN THE PARK.
- NO RIDERS, CAMPERS, OR SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED TO WANDER OUTSIDE OF THE PARK. THE ENTIRE AREA WILL BE FENCED WITH ONE ENTRANCE AND ONE EXIT. SECURITY WILL ASK ANYONE CLIMBING FENCES TO LEAVE.
- NO PIT BIKES, NO PIT RIDING, NO RIDING OUTSIDE OF THE PARK, IN THE PARKING AREAS OR IN SPECTATOR AREAS.

- NO DOUBLE RIDING, NO GIVING A RIDE TO ANYONE TO OR FROM THE TRACK.
- ONLY THE RIDER THAT IS SIGNED UP TO RIDE CAN RIDE. ALL MOTOR TUNING MUST BE DONE AT TRACK AREA AND ALL TESTING MUST BE DONE BY THE RIDER.
- NO DOGS, ALL MUST BE KEPT IN THE PARKING AREA AND ON A LEASH. NO ANIMALS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED IN SPECTATOR AREAS OR NEAR ANY TRACKS.
- ALL MOTORCYCLES MUST BE IN GOOD WORKING CONDITION, NOISE ISSUES AND OIL LEAKS MUST BE FIXED BEFORE ENTERING THE TRACK.
- RIDERS MUST OBEY ALL FLAGGERS, OFFICIALS, AND MXGP STAFF AT ALL TIMES.
- GUESTS AND MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEAN UP AND DISPOSAL OF ANY OILS, FUEL, RAGS, AND ANY OTHER GARBAGE OR DEBRIS.
- ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND ANY WEAPONS ARE PROHIBITED ON PREMISES.
- GUESTS AND MEMBERS THAT ABUSE ANY RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE WITH NO REFUND.
- MXGP IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOST OR STOLEN PROPERTY.

TRACK CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE:

- CONSTRUCTION OF THE TRACKS WILL BE DONE BY MXGP. THE TRACKS WILL BE BUILT TO AMA SPECIFICATIONS FOR WIDTH AND CORNER TO JUMP TO CORNER DISTANCES.
- ALL TRACKS WILL BE GROOMED EVERYDAY PRIOR TO OPENING.
- ALL TRACKS WILL BE WATERED WHEN NEEDED FOR DUST CONTROL.
- ALL TRACKS WILL BE MONITORED AND INSPECTED FREQUENTLY. HOLES, OR UNSAFE CONDITIONS WILL BE FIXED IMMEDIATELY.

FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE:

- CONSTRUCTION OF THE FACILITIES, PARKING AREAS, DRAINAGE WILL BE DONE BY A LICENCED CONTRACTOR.
- MAINTENANCE OF THE FACILITIES WILL BE DONE BY MXGP STAFF.
- ALL PARKING AREAS ENTRY ROADS WILL BE MAINTAINED AND WATERED FOR DUST CONTROL AS NEEDED TO ENSURE THAT NO DUST TRAVELS TO NEIBORING PROPERTYS.
- HONEY BUCKETS WILL BE SERVICED FREQUENTLY.
- ALL AREAS FOR SPECTATOR VEIWING AND EMPLOYEES WILL BE HANDICAP ACCESSABLE WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE TOWER

BUILDING. THIS BUILDING IS FOR THE USE OF THE PUBLIC ADDRESS ANOUNCER AND SPOTTER FOR THE MEDICS.

RIDER SAFETY:

- RIDERS WILL BE SEPARATED BY SKILL LEVEL, WITH A TRACK FOR ALL AGES AND SKILL LEVELS.
- RIDERS RIDING WITH THE WRONG SKILL LEVEL, SIZE OF BIKE OR AGE WILL BE ESCORTED TO THE PROPER TRACK AND MADE AWARE OF THE RULES OF THE TRACK.
- ALL TRACKS WILL BE CLEARLY MARKED AS TO THE DIRECTION OF FLOW ON THE TRACK AND THE SKILL LEVEL AND BIKE SIZE REQUIREMENT FOR EACH TRACK.
- ANY RIDER, OR BIKE THAT IS UNSAFE OR IS BEING OPERATED IN AN UNSAFE MANNER WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RIDE.
- PROPER SAFETY GEAR IS REQUIRED TO BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS. HELMET, BOOTS, AND EYE PROTECTION ARE REQUIRED.
- IF THERE IS AN INJURED RIDER DOWN ON THE TRACK THE TRACK WILL BE STOPPED AND ALL RIDERS WILL RETURN TO THE PARKING AREA UNTIL MEDICAL STAFF AND THE INJURED RIDER ARE COMPLETELY OFF OF THE TRACK.
- IF AN AMBULANCE IS REQUIRED 911 WILL BE CALLED. ALL TRACKS WILL BE SHUT DOWN AND ALL RIDERS MUST RETURN TO THE PARKING AREA UNTIL THE AMBULANCE HAS EXITED THE PARK.

INSURANCE:

- MXGP WILL CARRY A 2,000,000-DOLLAR INSURANCE POLICY LISTING SNOHOMISH COUNTY AS ADDITIONALLY INSURED.
- MXGP WILL HAVE INSURANCE FOR SPECTATOR LEGAL LIABILITY AND PARTICIPANT LEGAL LIABILITY.
- ALL MAJOR ACCIDENTS WILL BE REPORTED TO THE INSURANCE COMPANY AND AN ACCIDENT REPORT WILL BE COMPLETED.

MOTORCYCLE AND ATV SAFETY TRAINING:

- HONDA'S LEARN TO RIDE PROGRAM WILL BE OFFERED TO ALL RIDERS.
- MSF TRAINING COURSES WILL BE OFFERED.
- ATV TRAINING COURSES WILL BE OFFERED TO ALL ATV RIDERS.

ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS:

- ALL BIKES WILL BE SOUND TESTED TO MEET AMA SOUND REQUIREMENTS.
- FUELING OF BIKES MUST BE DONE IN DESIGNATED AREAS.

EMPLOYEES:

- ALL EMPLOYEE'S MUST READ THE SAFETY MANUEL, AND COMPLETE THE SAFETY TRAINING COURSE.
